SNOW REMOVAL PRIORITY

 Caution areas

Airport Administration is responsible for determining when snow removal operations are necessary. The determination is based on factors such as forecasted weather and accumulation of snow.

A NOTAM will be issued when conditions exist that could present a hazard to aircraft operations. If conditions persist to the point of aircraft safety, the Airport Manager may choose to close the field until conditions are safe for operations again.

Snow removal will occur in following order:

1. Runway 18/36 - **Priority #1**
2. Parallel Taxiway – **Priority #2**
3. Mid-field Connector Taxiway, Terminal Area Ramp - **Priority #3**
4. Major Taxiways and Taxilanes - **Priority #4**
5. Aviation Business's on the airport.
6. Individuals who have requested assistance with snow removal in front of their hangar. *Please note that snow will be removed up to 5 feet from facilities.*
7. Remaining taxilanes.

Ongoing snow conditions may result in returning to priority number one.

Tenants removing snow from their ramps should coordinate with Airport Administration to determine the best location to push snow. **Do Not** push snow into plowed taxilane/taxiways without discussing with Airport Administration beforehand.
